- The Church Mobilization ministry is funded by monthly faith promise support and offerings. - All projects are required to complete a Project Report Form.
- You are also responsible to provide full hookups (water, 50 amp electric, and sewer) for *RV Volunteers*.
- Upon approval of your project, we will promote your need for workers and endeavor to provide volunteers to assist you and your congregation with the construction of your facility.
- All projects are required to complete a Project Report Form on a monthly basis.

PRE-REQUISITES FOR BECOMING AN RV MINISTRY CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

RV volunteer ministry was designed to help projects that would have difficulty building or remodeling without the assistance of volunteer workers.

The following is the list of criteria currently used when requests are made to be an approved RV Ministry project. Projects are considered and evaluated on a case by case basis.

RV MINISTRY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To assist in the building or remodeling of Assemblies of God deeded properties
- Disaster relief due to wind, fire or flood damage if not covered by insurance

APPROVAL REQUIREMENTS AND PRE-REQUISITES

- Property must be owned and deeded to the Assemblies of God
- Project approved for 2 years, but can be renewed with reapplication process

CHURCH/FACILITY RESPONSIBILITY TO US MAPS DEPARTMENT

- Approved projects agree to support the Church Mobilization Department by:
 - O Giving a non-refundable \$150 processing fee with application
 - O Return monthly Project Report form of each labor hour worked by each RVer
 - O You are also invited to financially support us with a monthly Faith Promise to the Church Mobilization Department (via a Faith Promise form)

CHURCH/FACILITY RESPONSIBILITY TO RV VOLUNTEERS

- Provide full service RV hook-ups; water, sewer, 50-amp electrical, at each RV site
- Provide a project patch representative of the project (see enclosed patch info)

REASONS YOUR PROJECT MAY NOT BE APPROVED OR REMOVED

- Not an Assemblies of God deeded property
- Project too large, too high or too dangerous for volunteers
- Failure to complete Project Status Report Form


- Projects are approved for 2-year period, must renew after 2 years to extend
- The RV volunteer ministry is not a turnkey operation, but we will endeavor to help each project as much as possible toward completion

STEPS TOWARD YOUR NEW PROJECT

- Inform your district superintendent of your desire to use Church Mobilization for your project
- Complete the Project Information Form (PIF)
- Submit PIF along with the \$150 non-refundable fee
- Additional clarification on your project may be required
- Submit your building permit to our office ASAP, if required by your local government
- Projects may not be approved or listed as active without a building permit

Examples of Patches







One of the opportunities of being an RV project, is that you can provide each RV volunteer with a patch as a symbol of the time he/she spent working on your project. This is a great symbol of pride for the RV volunteers to share across the nation. There are a multitude of companies that provide customized items, both on-line and in your local area. Please feel free to utilize any company you desire.

Below are some specifications to assist you in your design.

- The patch should be no larger than 3" in size in width and height
- Patches can be any shape you choose, round, rectangle, triangle, etc.
- Patch design should be emblematic of your project/location AND should include your project name (church, campground, adult/teen challenge center) city, state, and if desire, year

The following information is provided to assist you in installing appropriate RV hook-ups for RV volunteers. These plans are intended to be used as a guideline. Adaptations may be required to fit your site.

The following should also be considered:


- 3 to 5 50 amp 220 volts hook-ups are ample for most projects. You should consult the Church Mobilization office to review your specific needs.
- Piping can be above ground, if permitted by your local authorities.
- Contact your local authorities and obtain any necessary permits for your temporary RV sites.
- Consider locating the site on grass or compressed stone as opposed to bare dirt.
- Be certain to follow all local plumbing and electrical codes.






